NOLA for Life Day January 10 at Sampson Playground

More than 32 community organizations with 150 volunteers turned out for the ninth NOLA For Life Day with the goal of revitalizing the Florida Desire neighborhood.

- Green Light New Orleans: installed 160 energy efficient light bulbs in residents' homes.
- Project Homecoming: painted and repaired park structures and fences.
- NOLA Trash Mob/YLC Recycles: filled 10 trash bags.
- Hike for KaTREEna: planted 24 trees
- Eradication and beautification efforts from 8 City departments.

In all, the City demolished 2 blighted properties, cut 10 overgrown lots, filled 80 potholes, repaired 21 street light outages, trimmed 9 trees, and removed graffiti. The event also included opportunities to apply for jobs with the New Orleans Police Department.
