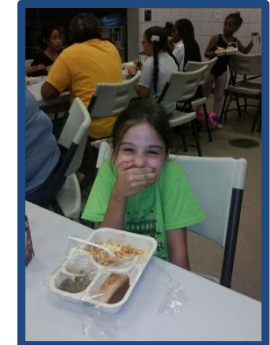

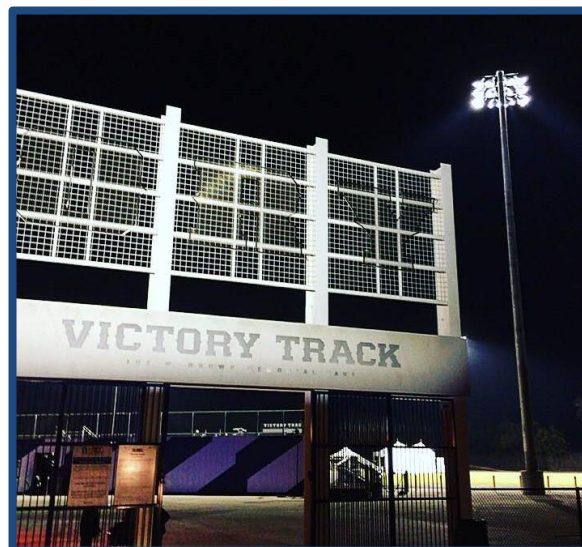

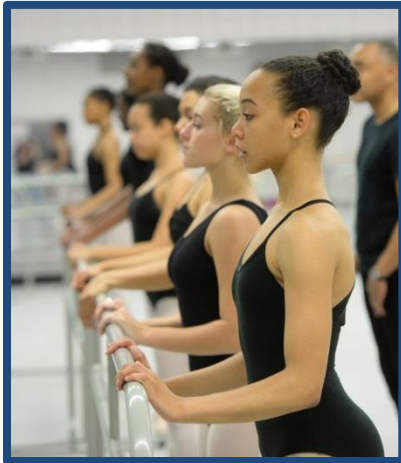


## Holiday Hours

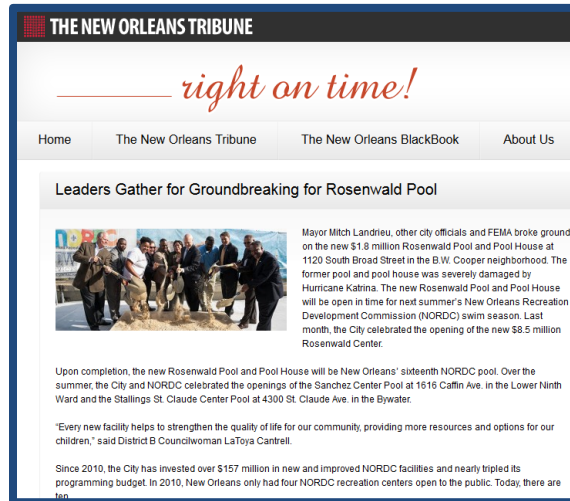
All NORDC Rec Centers, pools and tennis centers will be closed on Friday, December 25 (Christmas Day) and Friday, January 1 (New Year's Day).
